Today the hydrogen-fuelled HYSUN3000 reaches Marseille

Marseille (HYSUN). Today the hydrogen-fuelled HYSUN3000 stops in Marseille. The economical vehicle is supposed to consume only three kilograms of hydrogen on its 3000-kilometer-ride to Barcelona. This equals approximately the energy content of eleven liter gasoline or a consumption of 0,4 liter per 100 km. The vehicle is not conducted by professional drivers, but by members of the HYSUN-Team. "This ensures realistic conditions and is akin to the burden of the individual traffic", the Spokesman of the HYSUN-Team, Dr. Jörg Schweigard, points out. The German Federal Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation and Nuclear Safety has got the patronage for this record drive.

The vehicle started on 7th of September in Berlin. The next station is Perpignan. The 22nd of September the HYSUN3000 is supposed to arrive in Barcelona. If the construction team fulfils this plan, they should enter into the Guinness Book of Records. "We don't balk at the risk of such a public record drive, which has got a kind of experimental character", emphasises Frieder Herb, the project leader. It is hard to predict the Environmental conditions, like the state of the roads, the weather and the temperature. But the solely honorary members of the construction-team are sure that they will succeed with this charming record attempt.

One of the aims of the HYSUN-Team is to advert the people to the fuel cell technology. "If the public is behind such an intention, the politics and the industry will have it much easier to set the stage for this forward-looking technology", Schweigard feels confident about it. "If this happens, the HYSUN3000 will achieve its biggest aim."
